In order to provide a “face to face” education we are putting procedures in place to comply with the current health regulations. One of the initial procedures will be a health check in the morning, upon arrival.

Before entering the school, all keiki will be checked for the following:

- Fever (100.4 or higher) and/or chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Bluish lips
- Pink eye

*Parents MUST remain in their car with a mask on until the health check is complete. A table will be set up with an aide who will determine if the child can enter campus.

*Students MUST have a mask on when they arrive.

Due to the fluid nature of this pandemic, all procedures are subject to change as new research and guidelines are presented.
