The 4th-grade students have spent the past few years partnering with Malama Hule`ia making multiple trips to the Alakoko Fish Pond where our keiki assist with the conservation and restoration of this ancient Hawaiian archeological site. Our students learn the cultural significance of the fish pond and waters, the history of Native Hawaiians who cultivated the land as well as their farming and fishing practices. Students learn about the watershed, native plant species, and their uses, as well as the unique culture, history, and environment this watershed supports. This project ends with an environmental action project. Students can use the driving question: What can I do as a citizen scientist to ignite transformational change in my community?
