4) Financial Report (Treasurer) March 2024 Figures:

Total Raised: \$740.52

Total Spent: \$1,537.14

Balance: \$29,568.49

February Income was \$1,123.11 from hot lunches. Expenses totaled \$8,728.80. The majority of that was for 1 to 1 technology purchases (about \$6300), but 1st and 5th grade were helped with PBLs, there were two field trip buses, jog-a-thon expenses, and support for enrichment classes and the sunshine club.

March Income was \$740.52. Expenses were \$1,537.14. This went to two field trip buses for 1st and 7th grade, PBL support for 4th grade, and support for the sunshine club, enrichment classes, the recycling program and general support for tablecloths and signs. PTN overall balance is \$29,568.49.

Kauai Charity Walk

It's not a "massive lift" on the day of the event. The double zipline has been requested again. DJ will be leaving school early on May 3rd to meet the vendor to set up the zip line. There will be two sign up shifts for volunteers to help on the day of the event on May 4th.

6) Additional Update

On May 14th, a group called MCNA who has previously been in contact with us and previously donated to our school will be showing up with 500 people to do a LOT of work on campus. They asked for a list of wants, needs, etc and will be doing everything from landscaping to cleaning. In return, they asked if DJ could come to their banquet on either May 15th or 16th to accept a check. DJ is hoping to bring some of the keiki there to do a performance instead. He will work with Kate & Noelani.

7) Open Forum

There have been monthly meetings about the transition from Na Kupu Lau to Ho'ike. It's been a process, but it is going to be amazing! Every year has gotten better, and it continues to get more rooted to Hawaiian Culture. It is a huge event and this year will also be a schoolwide PBL. Last year PTN gave about \$1000 and this year Ms. Kate is looking at about \$1500.

Everyone agreed that this is a good use of funds. Ms. Kate presented her Ho'Ike proposal.
